#### II. Dress Code

The Congregation is a formal University event. Graduates should wear full academic gown and dress properly. Jeans, T-shirts & trainers are <u>not</u> appropriate for attending the ceremony.

### III. Procedures of Presentation

- (i) Graduates should stand up quietly and line up according to their order of presentation, along the designated aisle.
- (ii) The Master of Ceremonies (MC) will say: "Graduates of the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences (*for example*) will now be presented."
- (iii) The Presenting Officer (Associate Dean or Head of Department/School) will be invited to the lectern and start presenting individual candidate to the Presiding Officer (Faculty Dean).
- (iv) The Presenting Officer will say: "Mr Faculty Dean, I have the honour to present the following graduates of the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences."
- (v) The MC will then read the names of the awards according to the order of presentation.
- (vi) Each graduate, wearing hood and holding cap in the right hand (not applicable to the graduates of PgD awards), will ascend the stage, hand in his/her name card to the designated staff who will scan the name card with the QR code for reading out the name (including Dean's Honours List, if applicable) via a sound file and take photos with the Presenting Officer.
- (vii) The graduate will then move forward and stop before the Presiding Officer's Rostrum. He/she will bow to the Presiding Officer who will make a gesture to cap (except for graduates of PgD awards), then turn around and bow to the audience, descend the stage, return to the seat and put on the cap.
- (viii) The next graduate will repeat the procedures as described above.
- (ix) When the last name card has been read and the last graduate of the Department has descended the stage, the Presenting Officer will say: [Mr Faculty Dean, this concludes the presentation of graduates for the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences."]

(x) If there is virtual presentation of graduates, the Presenting Officer will say: "Graduates attending the Congregation virtually will now be presented." After the virtual presentation, the Presenting Officer will lead to applaud and say: "Mr Faculty Dean, this concludes the presentation of graduates for the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences."

[Same procedures apply to graduates of the other Departments & Schools.]

## IV. Photo/Video-taking Arrangements

- (i) Graduates will be invited to take group photos by Department and/or by programme after the Congregation at the podium (Logo Square). Announcement will be made during the briefing/rehearsal.
- (ii) Photos of graduates at the Congregation Sessions will be taken by professional photographers. Free download of graduation photos will be made available around late December 2024/ early January 2025. Details will be announced on the AR website in due course.
- (iii) There will be video recording of the ceremonies. Graduates will be informed via email/SMS when the video clips are ready for viewing after the Congregation. No downloading of the video clips is allowed.

### V. Collection of Dean's Honours List Certificate

Graduates on the Dean's Honours List will be informed of the collection method of their certificates by their respective Department/School.

### VI. Inclement Weather Arrangements

If Typhoon Signal No.8 or Black Rainstorm Warning or an 'Extreme Condition' announcement issued by the Government is in force <u>at 6:30am</u> on 7 or 8 November 2024, the Congregation Sessions scheduled on the affected date will be cancelled and rescheduled subject to availability of the venue. Graduates concerned will be informed of the rescheduled arrangements as soon as possible.

In case of the likely hoisting of Typhoon Signal No. 8 or issuance of a Black Rainstorm Warning or an 'Extreme Condition' announcement during the Congregation period, AR and the Faculty will decide whether the Congregation Session(s) scheduled that day or on the following day will be cancelled.
