# II. Order of Proceedings

## III. <u>Procedures of Presentation</u>

- (i) Graduates should stand up quietly and line up according to their order of presentation, along the designated aisle.
- (ii) The Master of Ceremonies (MC) will say: "Graduates of the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences (for example) will now be presented."
- (iii) The Presenting Officer (Associate Dean or Head of Department/School) will be invited to the lectern and start presenting individual graduate to the Presiding Officer (Faculty Dean).

- (iv) The Presenting Officer will say: "Mr Faculty Dean, I have the honour to present the following graduates of the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences."
- (v) The MC will then read the award titles according to the order of presentation.
- (vi) Each graduate, wearing hood and holding cap (not applicable to the graduates of PgD awards), will ascend the stage, hand in his/her name card to the designated staff who will scan the name card with the QR code for reading out the graduate's name (including Distinction/First Class Honours and Dean's Honours List, if applicable) via a sound file and take photos with the Presenting Officer.
- (vii) The graduate will move forward and stop before the Presiding Officer's Rostrum. He/she will <u>bow</u> to the Presiding Officer who will cap the graduate (except for graduates of PgD awards). The graduate will then turn around and <u>bow</u> to the audience. After that, the graduate will proceed to the left end, descend the stage, return to the seat and put on the cap.
- (viii) The next graduate will repeat the procedures as described above.
- (ix) When the last name card has been read and the last graduate of the Department has descended the stage, the Presenting Officer will say: [Mr Faculty Dean, this concludes the presentation of graduates for the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences."]
- (x) If there is virtual presentation of graduates, the Presenting Officer will say: "Graduates attending the Congregation virtually will now be presented." After the virtual presentation, the Presenting Officer will lead to applaud and say: "Mr Faculty Dean, this concludes the presentation of graduates for the Department of Rehabilitation Sciences."

(Same procedures apply to graduates of the other Departments & Schools)

# IV. Photo/Video-taking Arrangements

- (i) Graduates will be invited to take group photos by Department/School and/or by programme after the Congregation at Lam Tai Fai Amphitheatre located right outside JCA. Graduates will be informed of the order of programmes for group photo-taking in due course. Announcement will also be made during the briefing/rehearsal and after the ceremony.
- (ii) Photos of graduates at the Congregation Sessions will be taken by professional photographers. Free download of graduation photos will be available via online Congregation photo album from late December 2025. Details will be announced on the AR Congregation website in due course.
- (iii) There will be video recording of the ceremonies. Graduates will be informed via email/SMS when the video clips are ready for viewing after the Congregation. No downloading of the video clips is allowed.
